Licensor is at least 18 years of age, and or the legal guardian/custodian of the above named individual acting.

Licensor shall indemnify, defend and hold Licensee harmless from and against any and all suits, claims, liabilities, demands, costs, expenses, or damages arising out of Licensee's Use of the Material as provided herein or arising out of the breach of warranty or agreement made by Licensor herein.
